As you complete the 101s and can access your study abroad application, we ask students to continue their abroad research via our [website](#) and each partner university's website. This is also a good time to meet with one of our regional [Program Managers](#). Our Program Managers are ready to answer all your abroad questions.

As you research program choices, OGE recommends searching beyond the large cities and focusing on smaller, regional cities, in Europe and beyond. Students will learn in the Study Abroad 101s, that both the spring semester and large cities are the most popular choices. OGE cannot guarantee students will get their first or second choices. Please review fall options as well as less traditional locations. More competitive programs will list the typical number of applicants and potential spots available on their [Program Pages](#). The spring semester is competitive and students should plan well in advance, keeping in mind OGE's

responsibility to equally balance enrollment across the fall and spring semesters.
